Just a reminder that the Town Office is open to the public with our regular hours of Mon-Fri, from 8-12, 1-4:30. We are closed for lunch from 12-1.

We are also asking that only 1 person (or 1 household) enter the Town Office at a time in order to keep proper social distancing and enables us to clean/disinfect in-between residents.

### Planning a Wedding or a Reception? Here's What You Need to Know

**How Many People Can Attend the Ceremony?**



These rules apply to indoor or outdoor religious or non-religious wedding ceremonies.

Maximum 30% capacity of a facility or 150 people - whichever is less.




This allowable gathering size applies only to wedding ceremonies - not receptions.

No food or drink is to be served at the ceremony.

**Do People Have to Physically Distance?**

Yes!

Individuals must be separated by 2 metres, unless they're part of the same household.



If you don't have enough space to maintain appropriate distancing, invite fewer people. These rules apply to both ceremonies and receptions.

**Planning a Reception?**

Receptions must follow public health orders on gathering size limits, as well as Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan guidelines.

Indoor and outdoor gatherings may have a maximum of 30 people, as long as a two-metre separation can be maintained between individuals who are not from the same household.



Food or drink service must follow the guidelines for the venue where the reception is being held.

## Reminder of the Saskatchewan All Terrain Vehicles Act and the Town of Arcola Bylaws

The Town of Arcola would like to remind everyone of the bylaws in town regarding ATV's including quads, dirt bikes and off-road utility vehicles in town.

It shall be lawful to operate an ATV on all streets in the Town following the shortest distance from the place of residence/business to the nearest exit between the hours of 7 am and 11 pm from Monday through Saturday and from noon until 11 pm on Sunday, with the exception of Main Street. Crossing of Main Street may be made on Railway Avenue and Balmoral Avenue.

No person shall operate an ATV on any sidewalk, boulevard, school yard, park or playground within the town.

The Saskatchewan RCMP are reminding the public to operate an ATV in public areas, a person must be at least 16 years old, and hold a valid driver's license. Those who are between 12 and 15 years old may operate an ATV in public areas if they are supervised by someone who has a valid driver's license, or who has passed an approved ATV training course. A child under 12 cannot operate an ATV in public areas. You must be able to provide proof of insurance and every rider **MUST** wear an approved helmet and appropriate protective riding gear.
